Isaiah 51:9-16

Intro – Remembering what God has done is one of the best ways to grow your faith. The prophet Isaiah speaking on behalf of God is telling the people to look back at to what God has done. Is.51:1-2

- I. Remembering gives strength to His people. 9-11
 - A. Knowledge of past provision gives strength. Abraham, Egypt. Is.30:7
 - 1. God will always limit your time of testing. Is.43:2, 1Cor.10:13
 - 2. Can you recall difficult times God has brought you through?
 - B. Remember God's promise for our future. 2Cor.5:8, 1Thess.4:14
- II. Remembering gives comfort to His people. 12-13
 - A. We need not fear man. Luke 12:4-7, Phil.1:21
 - B. Have you forgotten who God is? Is.40:22-23, Col.1:17, Is.43:1
- III. Remember He protects His people. 14-16
 - A. Because He has a purpose for us. Jer.29:11, Rom.8:28
 - B. That purpose is to share the word of God. Phil.4:13
 - C. Let people know what God has done for you. Rom.10:17, Matt.5:16

Con. – Think of all that Christ has done for you and then share that with others.
