## THE PROMISE

Acts 13:26-39

Intro – Last Sunday we read where Jesus took the 2 disciples on the road to Emmaus and reviewed the OT prophecies about Himself. Jesus is the fulfillment those prophecies. Luke 2:11

- I. The promise was made.
  - A. The Pharisees would not believe it. Ps.78:11, Jn.12:37
  - B. They actually fulfilled prophecies by Crucifying Christ. (27) Acts 2:36, Jn.11:50-51
  - C. Even the tomb He was buried in was prophesied. Is.53:9
- II. The promise fulfilled.
  - A. Jesus did not remain in the grave. He rose again. Acts 2:24
  - B. Hundreds of people were eye witnesses this truth.

- 1. God had promised to raise Him up. (33) Ps.2:7-8
- 2. God had promised an eternal King. (34) 2Sam.7:16
- 3. God had promised He would not undergo decay. (35)
  Ps.16:10
- III. The promise applied.
  - A. Through Jesus you can have forgiveness. Acts 10:43, Col.1:14, Matt.26:28
  - B. Through Jesus you are set free. Rom.3:28, Rom.10:4
