- I. The wise and the foolish.
 - A. What makes one wise. Mt.7:24, prov.11:30, Prov.13:1,

Prov.29:8

B. What makes one foolish. Matt.7:26, Ps.14:1, Prov.29:11,

Prov.28:26, Lk.12:20

- II. You have to get your own oil.
 - A. Oil is symbolic of the Holy Spirit. Zech.4:1-14
 - B. Others cannot supply it for you. Matt.7:22-23
 - C. Only Jesus can give you the Holy Spirit. Acts 2:38-39,

Jn.14:16, Jn.16:7

- III. The Lord will return for the believers. Jn.14:3
 - A. The trumpet will sound. 1Thess.4:13-18
 - B. His return will be unexpected. Matt.25:13
 - 1. Everyone gets drowsy. Will there be faith? Luke 18:8
 - 2. The believers are ready. They have oil. Rom.8:11
